Initial Research Request

The Laboratory prohibits research, access, or use of NAGPRA material but other collections at the Laboratory of Archaeology are available for research to qualified researchers for scientific and educational research. Per Georgia law, the Laboratory prevents access to site location and information for the general public therefore; the Laboratory limits research and access to the collections to Laboratory staff, authorized visitors, and qualified researchers. Qualified researchers consist of professional archaeologists with at least a Master's Degree in Archaeology, Historic Preservation, Museum Studies, related field, official representative of a Federally recognized tribe or nation, be a current Registered Archaeologist with the Register of Professional Archaeologists, or students working in the field of archaeology under the supervision of a professional archaeologist. Due to Georgia law, site location and information is protected (OCGA 50-18-72[a][10]). Therefore, if you do not fall into those categories then we cannot accommodate your request. Please note various forms of consultation with descendant communities may be required depending on the institution that controls the collection.
