#### ***UGAL13284 Guirún/Albarradas Survey***

*Guirún topo map with sites.* The INEGI 1:50000 topographic map covering the Guirún/Albarradas survey area, with the field-numbered archaeological sites. 1 item, < 1 GB.

#### ***UGAL13285 Central Mixteca Alta Settlement Pattern Project (CMASPP)***

*Reports.* Two unpublished reports. "Monograph" is an earlier, much fuller version of what was later published as *The Origins of the Nñuu: Archaeology in the Mixteca Alta, Mexico. Resultados del Recorrido Regional de la Mixteca Alta Central, Oaxaca* is our final technical report to INAH. Both manuscripts have data not included in *The Origins of the Nñuu*. 5 items, 1 GB.

*Slides.* Scanned 35-mm color slides illustrating ceramic and lithic artifacts with their proveniences, and archaeological sites and landscapes. With photologs. 3887 items, 161 GB.
